

Instillation of Eye Drops / Application of Eye Ointment

What Do I Need To Prepare For The Instillation Of Eye Drops / Ointment?

- · Prescribed eye drops / ointment
- Tissue paper
- Contact lenses should be removed

How Do I Instill The Eye Drops / Ointment?

Steps

- (1) Eye drops should be instilled before applying eye ointment.
- (2) Check the expiry date on the eye drops / ointment.
- (3) Wash your hands with soap and water, then dry your hands thoroughly before and after instilling the eye drops / eye ointment.

(4) How to instill the eye drops:

- a. Gently shake the eye drop bottle before use.
- b. Tilt your head backwards slightly and gently pull the lower eyelid down with one or two fingers to expose the centre of eyelid.
- c. Hold the bottle 2cm above the eye and allow the drops to fall into the lower fornix.
- d. Do not touch the eyelids or surrounding areas with the dropper tip of the bottle.

(5) How to instill the eye ointment:

- a. Squeeze away some ointment before use.
- b. Tilt your head backwards slightly and gently pull the lower eyelid down with one or two fingers to expose the centre of eyelid.
- c. Hold the eye ointment in the other hand.
- d. Apply ointment onto the inside of the lower eyelid beginning at the inner to outer eyelid.
- e. Do not touch the eyelids or surrounding areas with the tip of the tube.
- 6 Gently close your eyes.
- (7) Remove excess drops / ointment with a tissue.
- (8) If more than one type of eye drop is required, wait for 5 minutes before instilling the next eye drop. Instil the eye ointment after all other eye drops have been instilled.
- (9) Store the eye drops and ointment as instructed.
- ① Discard the eye drops and ointment one month from the date of opening or otherwise instructed.

For how long do I have to instil the eye drops / ointment?


- Some courses of treatment may not require the entire bottle / tube to be completely consumed.
- Other courses of treatment may require continuing treatment till the next appointment. Please check with your doctor when in doubt.
