What Do I Need To Do Before The Surgery?

Unless advised by your surgeon, you should take your regular medications as usual before operation. Fasting must be in accordance to fasting guidelines as advised by the hospital.

Before Coming For Surgery, You Are Advised To:

- · Wash your hair and have a shower.
- Wash your face, including your eyelids.
- Do not apply make-up when you are reporting for surgery.
- Wear a clean set of loose-fitting clothing. We recommend that you wear a front button shirt and pants.





Can I drive on the day of my surgery?


Do not drive on the day of the surgery. You are strongly encouraged to arrange for someone to accompany you to your surgery.
